CRITERIA

**FOR AWARDING GRANTS IN SUPPORT OF ANGLICAN PROGRAMS TO BENEFIT
ABORIGINAL PEOPLES WITHIN CANADA**

NOTE: If successful, grant awards are disbursed annually following the May and October meetings of the Anglican Foundation of Canada's Board of Directors, and are awarded on the recommendation of the Catholic Apostolic Universal Church Trust Fund Advisory Committee. Original applications, in writing, must be delivered to the Foundation office by April 1st each year for the **May** committee meeting and September 1st each year for the **October** committee meeting. Failure to submit an application by the specified date will result in a deferral of the application to the next available meeting.

1. Programs must have been initiated by aboriginal community(ies)/organization(s), and must involve aboriginal people in their development, planning and implementation.
2. Programs must "benefit aboriginal peoples within Canada." Applications should indicate the benefits and how the proposed program will achieve them. This will be the prime criterion for the awarding of a grant.
3. Programs **must** be endorsed by an Anglican Diocesan Bishop or the General Secretary of the Anglican Church of Canada and *if applicable*, the National Coordinator of Native Ministries.
4. Applications should indicate the level of support (financial, contributed labour, etc.) as well as the sources of support (especially financial support). Preference will be given to programs having broad financial support, although financing solely from the Anglican Foundation is not precluded.
6. Building projects will **not** be considered; the fund is for programs only.
7. Awards will not be made to programs that have already taken place, or to ongoing operations. Repeat grants will not be made.
8. Preference will be given to innovative programs, programs of benefit to large areas of the church, lay training, programs for disadvantaged people and for those in urban centers.
9. Grants will not be made to individuals, but applications will be considered for assistance to individuals, such as travel grants, to be distributed by the program organizers.
10. If an applicant is successful, funding must be guaranteed prior to the disbursement of the Anglican Foundation of Canada grant award.
