Information for Organ Study Tuition Grants

1. Teacher or sponsor should supply a statement of support either in the space provided or in a separate letter.
2. References must include an Anglican Clergyman or Anglican Church musician. The referees should supply a statement of support on the application form or in a separate letter.
3. Applicant's educational record should include number of years completed of elementary school, high school or university; music diplomas, certificates, prizes or degrees; number of years of study (organ) and any other musical experience, e.g., piano, school choir, church choir, etc.
4. Applicant's statement should indicate why you are in need of a financial grant. What are your short-term and long-term goals? What are your career aspirations as they relate to this application?
5. Grants may be made for tuition, music texts or scores but not for travel, accommodation, or meals.
6. Applicants should note that they must have at least 50% of funding in place. Awards are granted based on funds available.
7. *Other sources of income* – List other sources from which you expect to receive assistance for your musical education, such as parents, church, bursaries, and scholarships. Please state how much you yourself expect to contribute to your music education expenses.
8. Applicants are advised that requests for grants must be received in the Foundation Office not later than the first Friday of April *each year*. Financial grants will be disbursed in June of the year in which they were granted.

The Committee meets annually on the first Monday in May. Applications must be received by the first Friday in April. Application forms are available from The Anglican Foundation of Canada website or office. One (1) copy of the application with all supporting documentation must be submitted by the deadline to:
