The A.E.J. Fulford Trust
Criteria for Grant Applications

The A.E.J. Fulford Trust is dedicated to the encouragement, promotion, development and enrichment of church music in the Anglican Church of Canada. The purposes of the fund are:

1. To sponsor and support (i) regional schools of Church Music in which several dioceses could participate, and (ii) diocesan schools of Church Music.
2. To sponsor schools for the training of choir leaders and organists.
3. To promote the publication of Church Music composed by Canadian Church musicians.
4. To provide choirs, which cannot afford the expense, with quality musical publications such as settings of church services, anthems, choral collections, etc.
5. To subsidize the travel expenses of Anglican choirs who wish to exchange with other choirs. Note: It is the policy of the trust advisory committee that tours outside Canada will be considered only after all other applications have been considered. In addition, 50% of such costs must be raised locally. Awards are granted based on funds available.
6. Parish or Diocesan applicants must include the Charitable Business Number.
Note: If the applicant is an individual, they will not be disqualified from receiving a grant for lack of a business number; however, individuals should have parish or diocesan approval. The approving body is then considered to be the applicant on behalf of the individual, and its charitable business number will be used.
7. Please include a complete budget for the proposed project. This should show sources of guaranteed revenue and assistance applied for but not yet granted.
8. Please make clear the exact use of the proposed Fulford grant.
Example: Bursaries to students at a choir school.
9. Please give estimated number of persons attending and /or participating in the event.
10. Please note, the following policy has been passed by the Fulford Trust Advisory Committee:

“Applications for educational training outside Canada will be considered providing the applicant returns to Canada to contribute to Church music for a minimum of at least two years.”

The Fulford Trust advisory committee meets annually on the first Monday in May. *Applications must be received by the 1st Monday in April each year.* Application forms are available from either The Anglican Foundation of Canada website or office. One (1) copy of the application must be submitted with all supporting data by the deadline date to:
