

# THE ANGLICAN FOUNDATION OF CANADA

## Criteria for Graduate Awards for Advanced Theological Study

1. An applicant is required to have completed a university degree (B.A. or equivalent) and a professional degree (M.Div. or equivalent) and be in good standing as a member of the Anglican Church of Canada.
2. An applicant is required to provide the names and addresses of three references to assess both the applicant's ability to undertake the program and how the church will benefit from their further education.
3. Applicants, engaged in postgraduate studies in theology, often pursue a career of tutelage and research in a Canadian Anglican theological school. Bursaries may be granted both for advanced Masters and Doctoral degrees, and for post-Doctoral research.
4. An applicant is expected to have been admitted to a postgraduate program or demonstrate that he or she is likely to be admitted. The Advisory Committee may grant awards conditional upon acceptance.
5. An applicant is required to submit a clear statement of intent for both the period of study and for the work he/she expects to undertake upon the completion of study.
6. Grants are not awarded for the Doctor of Ministry degree.
7. Due to a limited amount of funds, grants are unlikely to exceed \$1,000 for a year of study. Any individual may receive no more than three grants in any six-year period. Applicants are asked to demonstrate, on the appropriate form, that he/she has explored thoroughly the possibility of obtaining assistance from other sources, e.g., parish, diocese, archdeaconry, government grants, etc.
8. Applications must be submitted to the office of the Anglican Foundation of Canada by April 22<sup>nd</sup>. The Advisory Committee will meet in early May and recommendations will be submitted for approval to the Board of Directors of the Anglican Foundation, which meets in late May. Awards will be announced in June.
