**Information to make application:**

In 1994, The Rev. Canon Dr. Graham Cotter established the Sacred Arts Trust to provide Grants in support of the use of the arts in public worship (Liturgical Dance, Liturgical Drama, Music as used in conjunction with Liturgical Dance and Drama and Visual Arts). The Agreement to administer the Trust with the Anglican Foundation was funded by Dr. Cotter by a capital gift of \$100,000 (\$10,000 over ten years) that was reached in 1994. In 2001, an amendment was approved by the Board of Directors in order to broaden the type of projects in art and worship that can be supported and to bring equality to all ecumenical communities in which Anglicans participate. Only the earned interest is made available for distribution. The hope is that additional gifts from other sources will be received in order to build up the capital.

When making application for a grant, your application should clearly state the following:

1. Whether you are applying as an individual or as a group, along with your name(s), address, experience and qualifications for the activity for which you need a grant.
2. Which of the following, or which combination of the following, is the category in which your project falls:
  - a) Liturgical Dance
  - b) Liturgical Drama
  - c) Music, as used in worship and especially as used in conjunction with Liturgical Dance and Drama.
  - d) Visual Arts, including use of textiles, painting and sculpture.
3. Describe the project.
4. Is this grant to be used to support a Sacred Arts School, Workshop or Program?
5. Is this grant to be used as a bursary to enable study and work in advancing your skills in any of the categories of question 2 above?
6. Provide any other relevant information, including a budget. At least 50% of funding must be in place.
7. Recipients of grants will be expected to provide a report and evaluation of the project undertaken at its conclusion.
