CRITERIA FOR BURSARIES THEOLOGICAL STUDENTS

1.
 - a) An applicant will have completed a first university degree (B.A. or equivalent) unless:
 - i) He/she has been admitted to a Theological College.
 - ii) The bishops of his/her Ecclesiastical Province have agreed to his/her exemption from this rule.
 - b)
 - i) Applicants are required to provide information about their attendance at A.C.P.O. If he/she has attended, a copy of the A.C.P.O. report should be attached. If attendance is scheduled for later date, a copy of the A.C.P.O. report should be forwarded when available.
 - ii) In some situations, normal A.C.P.O. procedures may not be followed or appropriate. In such circumstances, the applicant should provide evidence of the recommendation for training leading to ordination. Whatever alternative evaluation procedure has been established and approved, as an alternative to A.C.P.O., must be supported with official documentation.
 - c) An applicant entering the first year of Theological study is required to provide a letter of reference from the Principal or Dean of the Theological College stating that he/she has been accepted for study.
 - d) An applicant entering the second and/or subsequent years of Theological study is required to provide a letter of reference from the Principal or Dean of his/her College each year. The letter must state that the applicant is fully qualified to enter the given year of study and should note any conditions, academic or otherwise, to entry and the reasons for the conditions. An application will be accepted and considered only if an applicant is qualified to enter the next year of study.
 - e) Applications must be approved in writing by the bishop of the diocese with which the applicant is affiliated.
2. Applicants may pursue studies at any accredited Canadian Theological College or in any Canadian Theological College or University theological program approved by the House of Bishops.
3.
 - a) On Page 3 of the application form, the applicant must provide an accurate statement of anticipated income and expenses during the proposed period of study.
 - b) Due to limited bursary funds, an applicant is required to indicate that he/she has explored the possibility of obtaining assistance from other sources.
4.
 - a) Applicants are reminded that fees vary greatly from one Theological College to another and the cost of living varies considerably from one community to another. Residence requirements also vary from one college to another. Applicants are advised to research the cost of living in the region they hope to study.
 - b) Bursaries may not exceed \$1,500 for an academic year.
5. The deadline date for the submission of applications is April 22nd. Applications will be submitted *en bloc* to the Advisory Committee and considered in early May. Applicants will be notified of the results in June.
6. Bursaries are **NOT** considered or awarded for undergraduate study.
