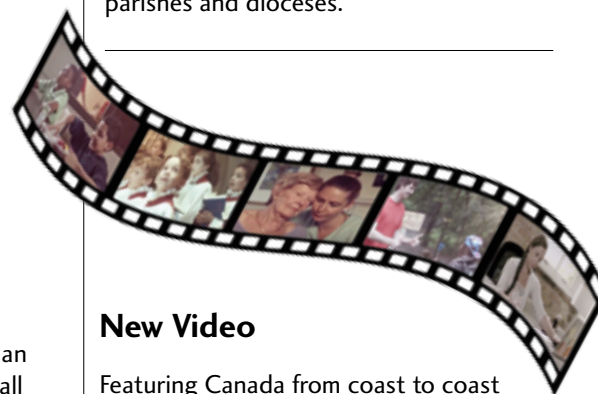
Children's Prayers for All Occasions
