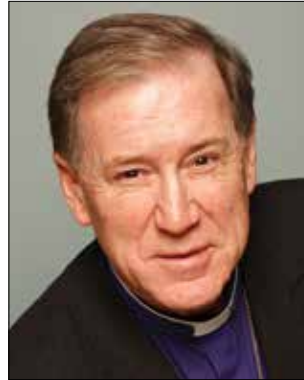

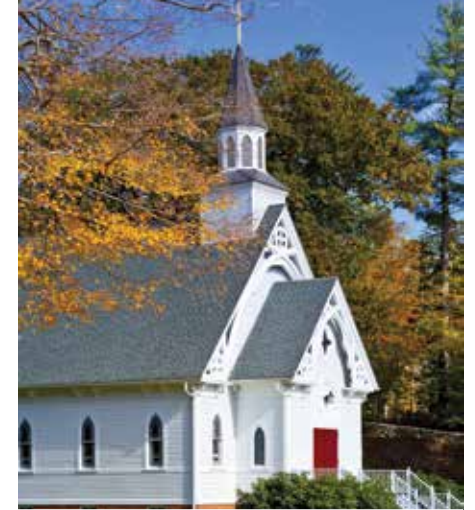

Building for the future

Over the years, AFC has made bricks and mortar a priority because it understands the importance of church buildings as places where people and communities gather on a regular basis. Churches are the places where rites of passage are celebrated: baptisms, confirmations, weddings, and funerals. How would we celebrate Christmas and Easter without those memorable children's pageants and Holy Week observances? Church buildings are also increasingly serving the needs of the community as a hub of activity and programming for people of all ages. Parish halls are used for public services such as food and clothing banks, legal clinics, language classes for immigrants, health and fitness seminars, and sanctuary for people in distress.

In addition to applications for infrastructure projects in 2017, AFC received a number of applications for new and creative ministry programs and theological formation across the country. The grants listed here demonstrate the breadth of exciting ministry undertaken by Canadian Anglicans from coast to coast to coast.

ST. PETER'S ON-THE-ROCK

Kirkland Lake, ON • Diocese of Moosonee

Sometimes in order to keep the doors open and the events going, you just need to get rid of old, rotting shingles and replace the roof! This was the case for St. Peter's on-the-Rock in the town of Kirkland Lake in northeastern Ontario. They had patched the old shingles for years, but there came a day when the old roof couldn't keep the rain out, resulting in damage to inside walls, buckling paint and drywall, stained floors and carpets. The church that used to be known by locals as “the church that is falling apart” quickly became “the church that got spruced up.”



ALL SAINTS, LADNER

Delta, BC • Diocese of New Westminster

Built in 1881, this Anglican mission church is the oldest in Delta, BC. In 2015, the vestry was presented with a comprehensive plan of much-needed renovations. The full scope included repairs and renovation to the kitchen, washrooms, furnace, roof, ventilation system, replacement of the drainage system around all foundations, installation of code-compliant emergency exits, and the list goes on. AFC assisted with the kitchen and washroom portion of this major undertaking in order to provide up-to-date facilities for a monthly community meal, Messy Church, and regular organizations that use the space.

PARISH OF ST. MARY WITH ST. MARK

Mayo, Yukon • Diocese of Yukon

In the “heart of the Yukon,” Mayo has a population of 450, many of whom are proud of their aboriginal roots. According to Bishop Larry Robertson, “In the Yukon, the church building is a spiritual focal point for the community.” And so, the parish decided to undertake considerable renovations in order that the building would be available for religious services and community events for years to come. One of the oldest buildings in the Mayo region, the parish was in dire need of structural and foundation work. AFC funds assisted with electrical upgrades and baseboard heaters to complement the wood-burning stove, allowing the whole community to benefit from the newly renovated space.



THE ROAD TO WARM SPRINGS— INDIGENOUS ANGLICAN GATHERING

Pinawa, MB • General Synod, Indigenous Ministries

The Primate described the Road to Warm Springs gathering as “Spirit-led in ever so many ways. In the long journey of partnership in building a truly Indigenous Church within the Anglican Church of Canada, the time in Pinawa will long be remembered as a watershed moment.” Sixty-eight individuals, including Indigenous and non-Indigenous people, as well as partners from the United Church of Canada and the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Canada, gathered together for the National Consultation on Indigenous Self-Determination calling upon bishops, clergy, and all the baptized to stand in solidarity with Indigenous Peoples in their quest for self-determination.

TEACH US TO LOVE!

- Diocese of Toronto

At St. John's, West Toronto, a team of ordained and lay people are creating a lectionary-based curriculum for children, including music, art projects, service and mission ideas, at-home resources, and videos. The goal is to publish the curriculum and make it available to Anglican parishes across the country. Based on the Marks of Mission, the theology is open, generous, and

expansive with the goal of empowering children to be life-long learners of the Gospel, and it is sensitive to different learning styles.



OUTDOOR BASKETBALL AND SKATEBOARD FACILITIES

- Diocese of Niagara

Recognizing a decline of young people in congregations, St. Christopher's, Burlington is going where young people hang out, and that just happens to be right next door to the church. Many of them come from low-income, single-parent families. They gather in and around the church where playing basketball

and skateboarding are two favourite activities. In an effort to reach out, St. Christopher's decided to install basketball nets in their back lot and create skateboard ramps for teens. "Meet them where they are" is their approach to innovative ministry.



REVITALIZATION AND RURAL MINISTRY

- Diocese of Central Newfoundland

Urban models of ministry do not always suit the unique, particular needs and necessities of rural ministry. The Diocese of Central Newfoundland knows this well and is taking steps to address declining membership. They have recognized a growth in social entrepreneurs who are fostering economic rebirth in key rural areas. The project

will entail two years of focused work with these entrepreneurs to develop new models of rural ministry that may be a resource across the country.



ALL ARE WELCOME

- Diocese of New Westminster

Within the parish of St. Faith's in Vancouver, St. Hildegard's Sanctuary is an inclusive, contemplative, arts-based Eucharistic community where participants use art, storytelling, simple movement, ritual silence, and simplicity to embody the message of God's healing love. Since 2016, St. Hildegard's Sanctuary has been developing alternative

liturgies that honour Anglican tradition and are accessible and life-giving to those who struggle with histories of trauma. Based on current research, they believe that in a congregation of 100 people, 60 will have navigated trauma, and up to 10 will be living with post-traumatic stress.

ST. STEPHEN'S ANGLICAN CHURCH

Ottawa, ON • Diocese of Ottawa

In January 2018, AFC Executive Director Judy Rois and the diocesan representative for Ottawa, Heidi Danson, joined the enthusiastic congregation of St. Stephen's in Ottawa's west end to participate in the official opening and dedication of a new lift. Since the church's move to Watson Street 65 years ago, it has steadily engaged in a renovation plan to maintain the building in good working order. Parishioners can now freely move up and down three floors thanks to the newly installed lift. The Rector, George Kwari thanked AFC for helping "make St. Stephen's dream of accessibility a reality."



ST. GEORGE'S ANGLICAN CHURCH

Lennoxville, QC • Diocese of Quebec

Situated in the city of Sherbrooke, Lennoxville is located at the confluence of the St. Francis and Massawippi Rivers, and home to St. George's Anglican Church, a prominent landmark in the region. Over the years, the rain, snow, coal heating, and an attempt to paint the rectory had discoloured the original red clay bricks and caused many of them to crumble. Thanks to the City of Sherbrooke and funding from the Anglican Foundation, St. George's was able to restore the brickwork of the rectory, hall, and church to their original glory. Parishioners say the face of the church is again ruddy and hale. It is a clean, attractive historic edifice in the heart of Lennoxville.

PARISH OF THE NERPIS AND ST. JOHN

Grand Bay–Westfield, NB • Diocese of Fredericton

In a town of 5,000 people just outside the city of Saint John, New Brunswick, the Church of the Resurrection in the Parish of the Nerepis and St. John has initiated an innovative project to provide an indoor play space for children up to 12 years old. The Play Park will be located on church grounds and will provide recreational opportunities for children and families in the community. The park will be a totally accessible space, welcoming and inclusive, open year-round. For many home caregivers, the winter months can be lonely and isolating, and so this community space is intended to counteract the negative effects they experience. The space has been intentionally designed to maximize child safety, while allowing for the flexibility of independent play stations for quieter children and children with special needs.

BURSARIES

Leadership

Leadership is always evolving as technology, innovation, and change accelerate. AFC recognizes that in today's fast-paced and complex environment, church leaders need to exhibit qualities such as intellectual versatility: that is, having a broad range of knowledge to be equipped to anticipate and lead change. They need to be authentic and reflective, collaborative and inspirational. Many researchers are saying that one of the most valuable assets of future leaders is their willingness and ability to be creative.

Donors to AFC are making it possible to train such leaders for the Anglican Church of Canada. Student recipients of AFC theological bursaries are enrolled in a variety of programs that will impact the church through ordination, chaplaincy, outreach, teaching, writing, and research.

OUR COMMITMENT TO CANADIAN THEOLOGICAL EDUCATION



HENRY BUDD COLLEGE FOR MINISTRY

The Pas, MB • Diocese of Brandon

Some students simply do not fall into the conventional categories of traditional educational programs. The cost of program fees and transportation to city colleges can be barriers to study. Henry Budd College for Ministry recognizes these challenges and has created a fund to provide bursaries for Indigenous students with the support of the Anglican Foundation.



QUEEN'S COLLEGE FACULTY OF DIVINITY

St. John's, NL • Dioceses of
Western, Central, and Eastern NL
& Labrador

Queen's College is now taking training for ministry courses into remote parts of the province with the help of AFC. "This project is all about innovation," says Provost Dr. Rick Singleton. The Diploma in Theology and Ministry program has been redesigned to provide local training at sites across the province. Highlighted are four pillars of ministry: good theological education, pastoral practice, spiritual development, and faith-based community learning.



MOOSONEE SCHOOL FOR MINISTRY

Cochrane, ON • Diocese of Moosonee

Recognizing a clear need for a different form of ministry training, the Moosonee School for Ministry was created for First Nations and non-aboriginal students to attend modules of study over the course of several weekends. Parish field work is undertaken between modules. AFC provided funding for students whose travel costs from remote parts of the diocese were prohibitive.



VANCOUVER SCHOOL OF THEOLOGY

Vancouver, BC • Diocese of
New Westminster

In recognition of new realities, VST has created a Contemporary Anglican Formation Program with the support of AFC grants. This innovative approach to learning features a weekend residential teaching retreat model with spiritual direction, pastoral care, and communal practices. Students preparing for ordained ministry are developing a meaningful sense of the ethos and culture of the Anglican Communion through this program.



MONTREAL DIOCESAN THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE

Montreal, QC • Diocese of Montreal

A newly designed Reading and Tutorial Program will launch in 2018–19, thanks in part to a grant from AFC. For almost fifty years, Montreal Diocesan Theological College has offered a fulsome academic and formation program that has catered to the unique needs of men and women preparing for ordained ministry. For many reasons, it has been a more suitable alternative to the traditional Master of Divinity program for a number of students. Now it's time for a face-lift as the college recognizes the changes in the Canadian religious landscape, increasing pluralism and diversity, and an expanding emphasis on mission and evangelism. This innovative program welcomes students from Labrador, the Lower North Shore in Quebec, and many other parts of Canada. AFC was delighted to offer a grant to assist with the expenditures associated with this curriculum redevelopment.

HAPPY CAMPERS



Camp at any time of the year can be a unique experience of community where kids, young people, even adults come together for a change in their regular routine. In a camp setting, participants develop a sense of independence, learn social skills and teamwork, and have new adventures away from home. Camps can provide a safe and fun environment where self-confidence is acquired, and new skills are cultivated. AFC was pleased to provide grants to a number of camps in 2017 for building upgrades, safety improvements, facility modernisations, and of course, campers registration fees.



ANGLICAN MEMORIAL CAMP

Diocese of Brandon

Located 100 km north of Brandon, Riding Mountain National Park is an island of wilderness surrounded by farmland and rugged nature. It's considered a jewel of the province. On the shores of Clear Lake in this park is Anglican Memorial Camp, which was established in 1950. Participants include children and youth of the diocese, both Indigenous and non-Indigenous; there is also a family camp and a women's camp. The beautiful setting

provides an ideal location for the nurture and development of the Christian faith amidst the tranquility and serenity of nature. AFC provided a grant to assist with a number of upgrades to the buildings to ensure that campers live, play, and sleep in a safe and secure setting.



CAMP OKEMA

Diocese of Saskatchewan

Located in the boreal forest of central Saskatchewan is Christopher Lake, one of the most beautiful lakes in the province. It is home to Camp Okema, a ministry of the Anglican Church but welcoming to all. The camp fosters self-awareness, creative potential, leadership skills, and spiritual renewal in a

picturesque setting. AFC was pleased to provide a grant to assist with upgrades to the infrastructure, including the men's and women's washrooms and the kitchen, so that campers could relax and rejuvenate during their summer experience.



SYRIAN REFUGEE DAY CAMP

Diocese of Quebec

With no single language in common, Syrian refugee children lived and played together speaking Arabic, English, French, Syriac, and Aramaic in the shadowy woods, verdant fields, and babbling brook of Quebec Lodge, the former diocesan camp on the shores of beautiful Lake Massawippi. The St. Francis

Deanery partnered with St. Ephram's Syriac Orthodox Church to bring dozens of refugees to Sherbrooke for a week of day camp. The combined outdoor activities, games, and skill development resulted in a camp experience that was the "best week of the whole summer" according to camp counsellors.



CAMP PAKWAWASKIHK

Diocese of Saskatchewan

Located in central Saskatchewan is Christopher Lake where St. James, Little Red River is building an Anglican community camp whose focus will be a healing journey for First Nations peoples. The Anglican Foundation provided a grant in summer 2017 to assist with a number of projects around the site, including purchase and hauling

of materials, exterior finishing to the second building constructed on site, completion of the cook house, and hauling of logs to a new hilltop residence building. Camp Pakwawaskihk is expected to open for summer 2018.



SACRED EARTH CAMP

Diocese of New Westminster

Salal + Cedar is an innovative ministry of the Diocese of New Westminster, an itinerant church rooted in the Fifth Mark of Mission: "To strive to safeguard the integrity of creation." The ministry runs a two-week residential camp to provide environmental leadership experience for youth and young adults learning about farming,

conservation, activism skills, and racial justice. The camp is structured to connect spirituality with sustainable environmental justice engagement. Within the cosmopolitan setting of Vancouver, Sacred Earth Camp is welcoming and inclusive of a rich diversity of young people who are passionate about caring for the earth.

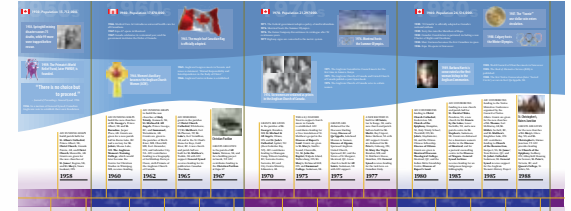

The answer is multi-faceted, but certainly their emphasis on prayer, worship, and rest, as well as their generous hospitality, combine to make the religious life for women a most worthy vocation. The religious life has a practical side too: in order to make the convent more accessible and compliant with building and fire codes, the sisters applied to AFC for funding assistance to install magnetic mechanisms to open and close the doors. It is now much easier for everyone, including those with mobility issues, to move from one section of the convent to another.
