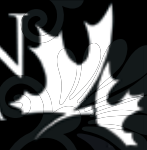

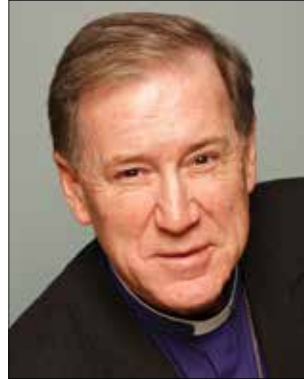

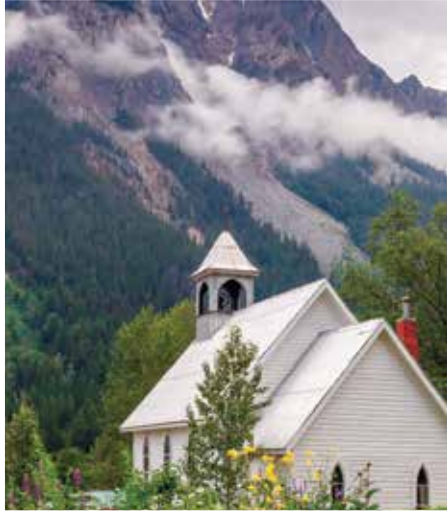

# GRANTS

## Building for the future

Over the years, AFC has made bricks and mortar a priority because it understands the importance of church buildings as places where people and communities gather on a regular basis. Churches are the places where rites of passage are celebrated: baptisms, confirmations, weddings, and funerals. How would we celebrate Christmas and Easter without those memorable children's pageants and Holy Week observances? Church buildings are also increasingly serving the needs of the community as a hub of activity and programming for people of all ages. Parish halls are used for public services such as food and clothing banks, legal clinics, language classes for immigrants, health and fitness seminars, and sanctuary for people in distress.

In addition to applications for infrastructure projects, AFC received a number of applications for new and creative ministry programs and theological formation across the country. The grants listed here demonstrate the breadth of exciting ministry undertaken by Canadian Anglicans from coast to coast to coast.

## HOME AWAY FROM HOME

Camp Medley • Diocese of Fredericton

Since 1947 Camp Medley has been a camp of choice for many of New Brunswick's young people. Keeping both indoor and outdoor facilities well maintained is an issue always under consideration. More than five years ago, the Anglican Foundation gave the camp a grant to assist with the restoration of the main hall and kitchen, and this year, it has given a grant to assist with the construction of an outdoor amphitheatre and performance space in honor of a young camper, Jonathan Young of Saint John, who died at age 11. With the camp's focus on education, health and wellness, the environment, and artistic expression, this new amphitheatre will be a welcome addition to the campus.



## BISHOP CYCLES ACROSS CANADA

Bishop Rob Hardwick of the Diocese of Qu'Appelle embarked upon a cycle journey across Canada to raise funds supporting Indigenous ministries, and to promote healing and reconciliation. His journey, which began in May in Victoria, British Columbia, took him through the summer to St. John's, Newfoundland: a distance of almost 7,000 kilometres. ## FROM REFUGEE CAMP TO SUMMER CAMP

Deanery of St. Francis • Diocese of Quebec

The Deanery of St. Francis understands the benefits of camp for young kids. When many refugee children from Syria settled in Sherbrooke, they knew that camp would be a great place for them. And so, for the second year, the Anglican Foundation has provided grants for refugee children to attend camp at Quebec Lodge, located on the shores of Lake Massawippi. According to Canon Giuseppe Gagliano, “The impact of camp like this on children’s lives is incalculable. Both newcomer and settled children will be given ample opportunity to interact and make new friends. The Deanery of St. Francis sees this work as part of its Christian mission to serve the Eastern Townships with Christ’s love. To transition from living in a refugee camp to playing freely on a Canadian lake is the embodiment of the kind of hope one seeks to share in Christian witness.” 9

## ROOTED IN PLACE, TRADITION & HISTORY

- Salal + Cedar: Sacred Earth Camp, Vancouver, BC

Do you have a love for creation? Then Sacred Earth Camp is the place to go. Located on the Southlands Heritage Farm within Vancouver's city limits, this teaching farm is dedicated to demonstrating and sharing sustainability, food security, and traditional farming skills. For two weeks, this environmental leadership program welcomes participants from Indigenous, Settler, and Migrant/ People of Colour youth to get to know their bio-region, learn about

the climate, engage with justice issues in Coast Salish territories, and develop practical skills and spiritual practices. Recognizing the critical significance of our climate, how it will change over the next century, and its vital importance for our economy and society, the Anglican Foundation of Canada is a proud second-year sponsor of this life-changing camp.



## FIRST NATIONS PEOPLE— CULTURE, FEASTS & EDUCATION

- St. Mary Magdalene's Anglican Church, Vancouver, BC

If you decide to attend St. Mary Magdalene's in the Greater Vancouver area, you will quickly discover a ministry to First Nations people and their loved ones called Urban Aboriginal Ministry, and its wide-ranging services and education are quite remarkable. Whether it's drum-making, beading, medicine wheel circles with smudging, or an educational workshop about the traditional teachings of Indigenous

ancestors, you're sure to find something instructive and informative. The Urban Aboriginal Ministry also provides practical things like food, furniture, clothing, and transportation in addition to culturally appropriate funerals and weddings. Being aware of our history and cultural differences and recognizing the beliefs, values, and traditions of Aboriginal Peoples are important steps on the path towards reconciliation.



## I AM A FEATHER ON THE BREATH OF GOD

• St. Faith's Anglican Church, Vancouver, BC

St. Hildegard's Sanctuary is an inclusive, arts-based, contemplative Christian community within the parish of St. Faith's in Vancouver. In 2017 the Anglican Foundation responded generously when St. Hildegard's applied for a grant to create liturgical resources for trauma-sensitive congregations. Their commitment to reconciliation led them to apply for a second grant through the Sacred Arts Trust for "Feather Dance"—a liturgical arts

project that is Indigenous-led and includes relationship-building through storytelling, wisdom-sharing, and community hand work. Inspired by Indigenous spirituality and the spirituality of St. Hildegard of Bingen, this project is an Indigenous/settler collaboration in the co-creation of liturgical textile arts, inspired by the phrase, "Thus am I, a feather on the breath of God."



## ACCESSIBILITY PROJECT

• St. Thomas Anglican Church, Vancouver, BC

It was 100 years ago that St. Thomas Anglican Church first appeared as a landmark in East Vancouver. It has been a gathering place for Christian worship, spiritual nurture, and outreach ever since. When its first Rector arrived in 1914, St. Thomas soon had to construct a Sunday School building to accommodate the growing number of families who joined the parish. Forty years later, it expanded the church building and opened a new church hall. And now in 2018, the congregation is

engaged in a major renovation to make the facility wheelchair accessible. A lift will be added to access all three levels of the building, as well as fully accessible washrooms. Extensive renovations to the lower hall are also being done to provide a welcoming and functional meeting space and kitchen for the congregation and local community.

## LITURGIES ONLINE

St. Aidan Anglican Church, Moose Jaw, SK

• Diocese of Qu'Appelle

Luke Johnson, the youth minister at St. Aidan Anglican Church in Moose Jaw spent the past five years creating liturgical resources for youth and circulating them through a website called "GetLiturgized." The site now has Bible studies, activities for youth, and a number of liturgies that are simple to use with a collect, psalm, creed, prayers, and doxology suited to different seasons. The liturgies are flexible and adaptable to the audience, culture, and social setting. Maybe that's why so many youth connect to it. The Anglican Foundation has supported GetLiturgized for three years, helping youth push the church forward in completely new ways.



## CLAY—CANADIAN LUTHERAN ANGLICAN YOUTH GATHERING

Thunder Bay, ON • Diocese of Algoma

In August 2018, 850 young people gathered in Marina Park with the local community in Thunder Bay, Ontario, including Indigenous elders, community leaders, and bishops. Embodying the theme of *Threads*, they listened to stories about Thunder Bay, about faith, and about hope in the midst of desperation—stories that were woven together in the tapestry of faith. After the storytelling, they walked in a procession to the Spirit Garden where they learned about the Seven Fallen Feathers (Indigenous students who died in Thunder Bay after moving to the city to attend high school). This Public Witness Event was a deeply moving event for the participants and the local community.

### WALLS AND WALKWAY

St. John's Anglican Church, Bath, ON

Located just west of Kingston, Bath lies along the shore of a secluded cove offering a welcome stop for sailors. Central to this lovely village sits the 200-year old historic church of St. John's. In 2018 it was time for a change for the church and the community. As the village of Bath has undergone a dramatic transformation over the last twenty years, St. John's has rallied by creating a strategic plan for the future that includes responding to the ministry opportunities that a transformed village places before them. They called their project "Walls & Walkway." The renovated walkway welcomes everyone to the church, increasing accessibility, and sturdier walls will keep them safe once they're inside.

## Leadership

Leadership is always evolving as technology, innovation, and change accelerate. AFC recognizes that in today's fast-paced and complex environment, church leaders need to exhibit qualities such as intellectual versatility: that is, having a broad range of knowledge to be equipped to anticipate and lead change. Many researchers are saying that one of the most valuable assets of future leaders is their willingness and ability to be creative.

# OUR COMMITMENT TO CANADIAN THEOLOGICAL EDUCATION



## QUEEN'S COLLEGE FACULTY OF DIVINITY

St. John's, NL • Dioceses of Western, Central, and Eastern NL & Labrador

In order to meet the need in smaller and sparsely populated areas of the province, Queen's College launched a Diploma in Theology and Ministry program in Gander, Corner Brook, and Happy Valley-Goose Bay as well as a Certificate in Supervision in Ministry and a Certificate in

Spiritual Direction. Wouldn't the first bishop of Newfoundland be proud? In 1841, Aubrey George Spencer established Queen's College to offer training for ordained ministry. For 178 years, approximately 500 graduates have been ordained for ministry across Canada and around the world.



## HENRY BUDD COLLEGE FOR MINISTRY

The Pas, MB • Diocese of Brandon

Some students simply do not fall into the conventional categories of traditional educational programs. The cost of program fees and transportation to city colleges can be real barriers for study. Henry Budd College for Ministry recognizes these challenges and has created a fund to provide bursaries for

Indigenous students with the support of the Anglican Foundation.



## HURON UNIVERSITY COLLEGE

London, ON • Diocese of Huron

In addition to providing bursaries to theological students, AFC provided a grant for the Centre for Public Theology located in the Faculty of Theology at Huron University College to compile a collection a collection of essays concerning the social implications of Bill C-14: An Act to Amend the Criminal Code and to make Related Amendments to other

Acts (Medical Assistance in Dying). The plan is to host consultations with representatives of the Anglican Church of Canada, scholars, legal experts, and clinicians on this subject of relevance and pastoral urgency in Canadian society.



## VANCOUVER SCHOOL OF THEOLOGY

Vancouver, BC • Diocese of New Westminster

In recognition of new educational demands and realities, VST has created a Contemporary Anglican Formation Program with the support of multiple AFC grants. This innovative approach to learning features a weekend residential teaching retreat model with spiritual direction, pastoral care, and communal practices. Students preparing for ordained

ministry are developing a meaningful sense of the ethos and culture of the Anglican Communion through this program.



### **ATLANTIC SCHOOL OF THEOLOGY**

Halifax, NS • Diocese of Nova Scotia & PEI

Constructed in 1955, the AST residence building, which houses a student residence as well as faculty and administrative offices, was beginning to show its age. Engaging upon an ambitious renovation, it was no surprise that the building crew discovered some additional problems underneath the surface of old shingles and patch-work repairs. Recognizing

the importance of maintaining theological colleges and residences in excellent condition, the Anglican Foundation was pleased to be able to offer a building grant to undertake a comprehensive renovation.



### **WYCLIFFE COLLEGE**

Toronto, ON • Diocese of Toronto

The principal, faculty and students at Wycliffe College understand that preaching is a “core pastoral function and one of the most challenging aspects of pastoral ministry.” In a rapidly changing culture, it is important for those engaged in preaching to periodically be refreshed and equipped to address contemporary issues. The Anglican Foundation

has partnered with Wycliffe College over the past 10 years to host a one-day preaching conference that welcomes people from many denominational churches while maintaining a distinctly Anglican imprint.



### **MOOSONEE SCHOOL FOR MINISTRY**

Cochrane, ON • Diocese of Moosonee

Though this Council of the North diocese has long encouraged people to attend theological institutions, it is not always feasible. Travel from northern communities is expensive, and in some cases, means leaving families and full-time jobs behind. The Moosonee School of Ministry offers an alternative solution. The school consists of four terms over the course of a year, each condensed into a three-day weekend in Cochrane. These busy weekends are packed with lectures from speakers from the diocese and across Canada. Along with a curriculum including Scripture, liturgy, and church history, each term has a component of Indigenous teaching on topics such as Indigenous spirituality and history. Between these weekends, students are also required to complete fieldwork in their home parishes.

## MAKE FRIENDS, DISCOVER TALENTS, INSPIRE DREAMS

YouthNet at St. George's Round Church, Halifax, NS

For the third year, the Anglican Foundation of Canada has supported this exciting after-school program for young people with total funding of \$25,000. St. George's YouthNet is now in its 20th year providing opportunities for teens in the north end of Halifax to grow, challenge themselves, and dream of bright futures. They do this through a lunch program, group discussions, cooking classes, team-building activities, and summer camps. The teens who attend

love the art classes, the music lessons, canoeing, hiking, and the encouragement to engage in creative writing, poetry, and story-telling. Their testimonials speak of increased self-confidence, enhanced leadership skills, and a greater willingness to try new things outside their comfort zone, all in a safe and encouraging, supportive environment of staff and many volunteers. Listening to the voices of our young people is absolutely vital to our country and to a prosperous society. This is what YouthNet is all about.



## STEAMER BOILER TO HEAT PUMPS

St. George's, New Glasgow, NS

Sound exciting? Well, in fact this project is rather exciting for the small parish of St. George's in New Glasgow, a town in Pictou County with a population of just over 9,000. While their congregation may be aging, their energy is pumped for the new heat pumps. As we all know, those old oil tanks buried in the ground can be dangerous, breaking down over time, and leading to expensive leaks. Deterioration of the metal tank, exterior corrosion from the surrounding soil, or water and

sludge inside the tank can cause devastating environmental results, including contamination and reeking odours. The solution: removal and replacement. The installation of new heat pumps has increased energy efficiency and reduced overall costs for the parish.



## A NIGHT OF ENCHANTMENT IN WOLFVILLE'S CEMETERY

St. John's Anglican Church,  
Wolfville, NS

When you hear the words “ghost walk,” it may conjure up a nightly walking tour with lantern-light, hearing about the haunted history of an area, local legends, eerie sounds, shadowy figures—enough to frighten even the most courageous of us all. But that's not quite what St. John's Anglican Church had in mind as part of its 200th anniversary celebrations. Rather, their version of a “ghost walk” was a celebration of many former parishioners. St. John's long and

prolific history make it a perfect setting for a walk down memory lane. Many of those buried in the cemetery were significant members of the community and faithful Anglicans. St. John's teamed up with Valley Ghost Walks to provide a cemetery tour for the parish, where those attending would meet former parishioners whose stories would be “brought to life” using community actors. Through its Sacred Arts Trust, AFC was pleased to offer a seed money to get this most interesting project off the ground. And if you happen to catch a fleeting shadow of a bishop while walking through the cemetery, don't be scared. It's probably the Right Rev. John Inglis, third bishop of Nova Scotia, who consecrated the burial grounds in 1826.



## ALL SAINTS' HAS A LEAK!

Parish of Avon Valley, Leminster, NS

One of five churches in the Parish of Avon Valley, All Saints' discovered water leaking through the roof and steeple. This beautifully constructed rural church, built in 1871 by local craftsmen, is at the centre of the village of Leminster and a place of pride for the community. When water began dripping through the roof last year, the parishioners decided they wanted a permanent repair rather than a short-term fix. The four other churches of the Parish of Avon Valley have a vested interest in the long-term viability and sustainability

of All Saints' Church. According to one parishioner, “In its own quiet and humble way, the day-to-day operation of the parish reflects the biblical way of the sharing of the apostles.” Not only do the parishioners of the four churches have connections that run deep, so do those who live in Leminster and its surrounding small communities. With a heritage grant, parish funds, investment income, community fundraisers, and an Anglican Foundation grant, All Saints' is able to move forward with a long-lasting repair: no more leaks, but rather a beautiful steeple and bell tower of which to be proud.

# HOPE BEAR TURNED 7 YEARS OLD

Hope Bear joined the Anglican Foundation of Canada in 2011 as a tangible reminder that the Anglican Church cares for kids in Canada. After lots of conversations with Anglican kids and youth across the country, these four areas of support were agreed upon for the Kids Helping Kids Fund:

- providing kids a nutritious breakfast before school
- helping kids with homework after school
- caring for kids with a terminal diagnosis
- giving kids a chance to go to summer camp or choir school

With every \$20 donation to the Kids Helping Kids Fund, you can receive a Hope Bear and know that your donation is making a meaningful difference in a child's life. Since its inception, donations to the Kids Helping Kids Fund have resulted in over \$80,000 disbursed across the country to help make the lives of Canadian youth a little brighter.

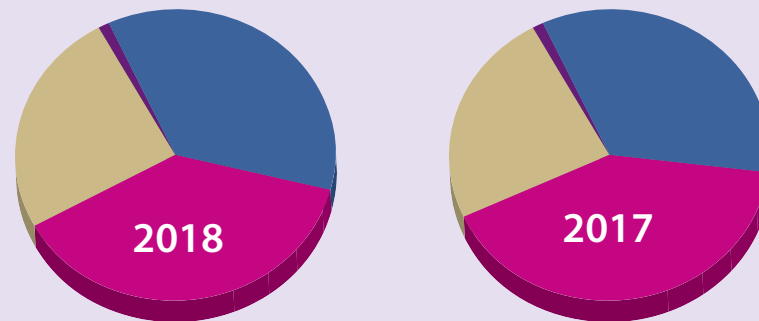

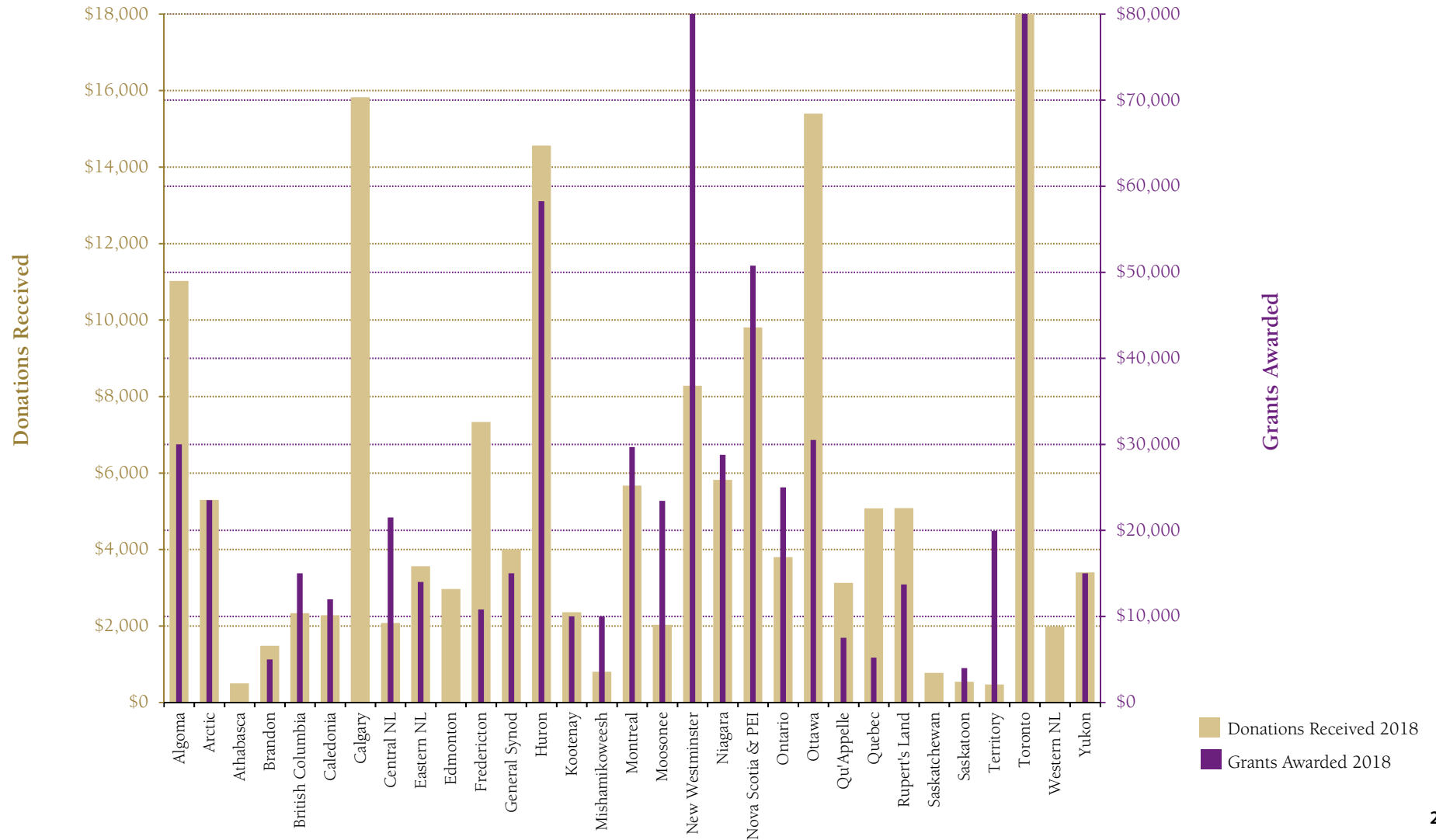

# SUMMARY OF EXPENSES



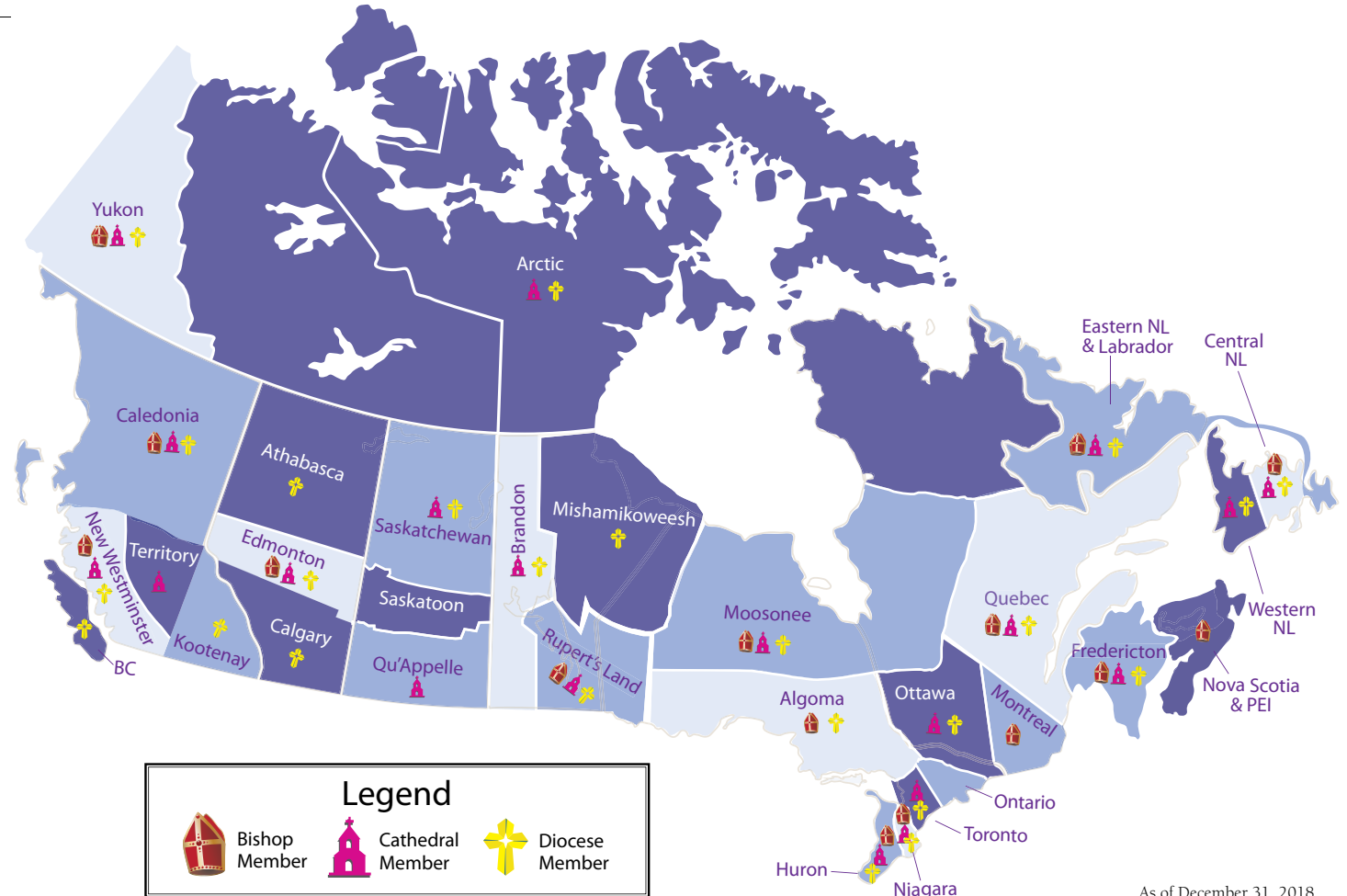

## THE BIBLE IN CREE

Wycliffe Bible Translators and the Indigenous Spiritual Ministry of Mishamikoweesh, Kingfisher Lake, ON

Translating Scripture does more than help Cree people encounter God. Even people of Cree heritage who may not live in isolated communities and are fluent in English benefit from reading the Word of God in their mother tongue. Scripture becomes living and real in the languages of our communities. One Cree woman reported that reading Scripture materials in her own language made her feel “complete somehow.” Three years of funding from AFC have helped this ongoing project to make translation of the Bible possible in five different Cree languages through Wycliffe Bible Translators of Canada.

## MIGRANT FARM WORKERS PROJECT

For the average migrant farm worker, the labour can be back-breakingly difficult, working 10–12 hour days for 5–8 months each year. There are about 600 migrant farm workers in the Grimsby, Lincoln, and West Lincoln area. St. Alban's Anglican Church in Beamsville is reaching out to them by providing meals and a Spanish language worship service. During that time, they can see a Spanish-speaking volunteer nurse or doctor. They can get free winter clothing, a bicycle, helmet, and vest. They can access free WIFI and use the Internet Café to call families in their home country. They can participate in English classes, socialize, and receive help with their taxes. For 3 years, the Anglican Foundation has made funding possible for ministry among these workers who are a vital part of Canada's economy.
