

CRITERIA FOR THEOLOGICAL EDUCATION BURSARIES

1. Applicants must have already completed an undergraduate university degree (B.A. or equivalent) unless the educational institution has agreed to an exemption.
2. Applicants may pursue studies at any accredited theological college or in any college or university theological program in good standing with the Anglican Church of Canada.
3. The bursary award may range between \$1,500 and \$2,500 for an academic year (September through August), depending on the funds available in any given year.
4. Applicants may not receive more than one bursary per academic year (September through August), with a maximum of three bursaries per degree program.
5. Applications submitted by the April deadline are intended for the following academic year (September through August). Applications submitted by the September deadline are applicable to the current academic year (September through August).
6. Applicants are advised of the results within two weeks following the meeting at which the Board of Directors considered the application.
7. Bursary funds are distributed through the theological college at which the student is enrolled.
8. Supporting documentation:
 - Personal statement (see item 3 of the application form).
 - Names of three references: one academic, one church-related, one character (see item 6 of the application form).
 - A letter of reference (template attached) from the principal or dean (or equivalent) of the theological college confirming acceptance or continuance in the program.
 - A letter of reference (template attached) from the bishop of the applicant's home diocese. (This letter is not required for lay applicants whose intended career path does not include ordination.)
