Across the Canadian church, there are seeds of ministry waiting to be sown, green shoots taking root, and others growing stronger every day. They all need life-giving water to flourish where they have been planted: serving young people in their communities and energizing our church.

Since 2011 the Anglican Foundation of Canada (AFC) has awarded more than \$1.5 million in youth-focused grants across Canada.

In 2021 alone, after the launch of Say Yes! to Kids, AFC granted an astonishing \$470,000 in funding to 79 grant recipients. All the projects were different, but they shared a common goal: to imagine more and to put that imagination into action to grow a brighter future for young people, today.

In 2022 we are taking the next step in igniting a nationwide movement for children, youth, and young adults. By working in partnership with churches across Canada through Say Yes! to Kids, we will lead a national peer-to-peer fundraiser to create a sustainable, abundant, source of funding for youth-focused ministry.

Prioritizing Youth Mental Health in Fredericton

"In the Diocese of Fredericton, we have a long history of supporting camping ministry with events which meet some of the varied interests of our young people. There are traditional diocesan camps across two venues as well as Choir School and St. Michael's Conference.

It has also become apparent, through a report from the provincial youth advocate's office, that mental health issues amongst our young people need serious attention. We are currently determining initiatives in these two areas to receive the diocesan portion of this year's Say Yes! to Kids funds. We also look forward to the local projects which will come out of the campaign."

The Say Yes! to Kids Movement

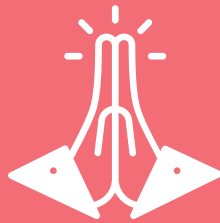
