

Say Yes! to Kids projects are all different, but they share a common goal: to imagine more and to put that imagination into action to grow a brighter future for young people.

Across the Canadian church, there are seeds of ministry waiting to be sown, green shoots taking root, and others growing stronger every day. They all need lifegiving water to flourish where they have been planted: serving young people in their communities and energizing our church.

Since 2011 the Anglican Foundation of Canada (AFC) has awarded more than \$1.5 million in youth-focused grants across Canada.

In 2021 alone, after the launch of Say Yes! to Kids, AFC granted an astonishing \$470,000 in funding to 79 grant recipients. All the projects were different, but they shared a common goal: to imagine more and to put that imagination into action to grow a brighter future for young people, today.

In 2022 we are taking the next step in igniting a nationwide movement for children, youth, and young adults. By working in partnership with churches across Canada through Say Yes! to Kids, we will lead a national peer-to-peer fundraiser to create a sustainable, abundant, source of funding for youth-focused ministry.

Montreal Mission Internship

MMI is a summer-long program that provides the opportunity for service-learning and vocational reflection to young people in the context of a supportive Christian community. Over the course of the program, young people are enabled to put their faith into action and discern their calling in our changing world against the backdrop of one of Canada's most vibrant, diverse, and plural cities.



Why now?

The Covid-19 pandemic has challenged many young people, disrupting their education and social life. The last two years have also made clear the scope of the challenges we face as a society. MMI provides an opportunity for young people to make meaningful change and connection in this increasingly complex landscape in which they are coming of age.

Our mission

MMI provides interns with the opportunity to follow their passions and serve in an area of need that is close to their hearts. We allow time for personal reflection, community building, spiritual growth, and learning through workshops and group meetings. We give our interns a platform from which to use their voices, become leaders, and act as changemakers in the community.

Our Fundraising Goal: \$5,000

Every \$5,000 raised provides a young person with a transformative, 9-week paid internship experience where they can spend their summer serving God, discerning their passion, growing in love while also receiving fair compensation.

Help expand our reach

As the cost of living rises steadily, money can be a serious barrier for young people seeking opportunities for growth. We want to enable more young people from all across the country to benefit from the MMI experience. With the generosity of our donors, we can reduce financial barriers to participation.





Promote Service-learning

The service-learning placement is the heart of the MMI program. Placements may include work at one of Montreal's many faith-based service organizations. Be it homelessness, food insecurity, or migration, placements are carefully chosen and arranged based on the participants' interests, the quality of supervision, and the availability of meaningful work.

Support a young person's journey

The COVID-19 pandemic has stalled the lives of many young people on the verge of adulthood. Your gift will give one more young person access to a high-quality paid internship that will help launch them onto a path they are passionate about and provide them with the community support and opportunities for vocational growth that have been sorely lacking during the pandemic.

This year, we will designate the diocesan portion of Say Yes! to Kids funds to go the extra mile for these children: outfitting them with the necessary camping supplies—bathing suits, sunscreen, sleeping bags, etc.—to have a truly successful camp experience."




















The Say Yes! to Kids Vision
